Keeping sabbath, not just on Sundays but throughout the entire week in an integrated way, keeps us sane, says Donna Schaper. While our culture pushes us to move faster, work harder and acquire more money and stuff, sabbath observances promote play, rest, love and worship.

"Sabbath — time for God — is a gift in its origin and in its keeping," Schaper writes in *Sabbath Keeping* (Cowley Publications). "It is not another must; it is a may. God invites us to keep sabbath; God does not demand it."

The commandment to keep the Sabbath day holy, she notes, "is an invitation to a party, not to a hanging. Sabbath keeping is not one more thing to add to our already long lists. [It] is lightness, not heaviness."




Chili Cook Off!

If you are interested in bringing a chili, please let us know so that we can prepare the electrical outlets.



Review of Fall Events



fall fair

Trunk or Treat This fall, on October 30th, we held a community-wide Trunk-or-Treat event in our church parking lot. Church members donated candy and many brought their cars which were decorated in various themes. Home Depot made a very generous donation of wooden grade stakes and yellow caution tape which were used to make a 60' x 75' corn-less corn maze on our back lawn. The maze took four people four hours to construct following an idea and plan from the internet. We promoted our event heavily on Facebook in multiple community groups. The day came and the weather was beyond perfect – very warm temperatures for the end of October – and it didn't rain! The event was scheduled for 3:00-4:15 and shortly after 2pm guests began arriving. Complimentary refreshments of cider, hot cocoa, and donuts were set up and families enjoyed visiting the decorated cars, the maze, and sitting on the lawn enjoying their time and snacks. Impromptu parking attendants needed to spring into action as the crowds kept coming – cars were parked on any available lawn space that could be found. Over 250 children were in attendance, and we were very pleased to have an opportunity to host a community event.

Church Fair It was very exciting to open our church doors again this fall and welcome the public into our building for our annual fair – our last fair was held in 2019. We weren't sure what to expect for community attendance and despite the town meeting being held the same day, there was a steady stream of traffic. The Cookie Walk was very popular and at one-point cookies were selling at an alarming rate – it was feared they would run out before Noon! We sold over 1400 cookies and over 900 pieces of fudge – that's a lot of baking! Visitors remarked numerous times about how wonderful everything was and that they could not wait to come again. Even the weather was cooperative so the corn-less corn maze was able to be enjoyed by some. The Proceeds were donated to the Wilmington Food Pantry and also put towards the purchase of a generator for a church in Ukraine. A small amount was given to the church operating fund to cover the cost of heat. It's never too early to think about the next fair – we collect white elephant items year-round, and they can be placed in the closet in Fellowship Hall.
